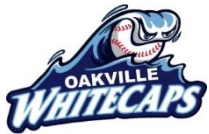

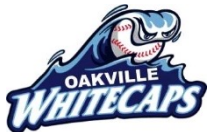

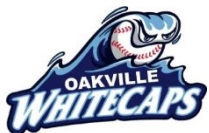

- Team Administrative Manager/Treasurer –

Overall team manager, manages bank accounts, budget and finances, books team accommodation when necessary.

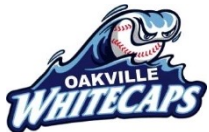
- Fundraising/Sponsorship Chair -

Works with the Administrative Manager to plan and execute all fundraising/sponsorship activities. Will work with league Tournament coordinator.

- Parent Rep –

Acts as a liaison between the parents and the coaching staff as it relates to potential opportunities, issues or general questions that may arise.

# Volunteers Required

- [Safety Manager](#) – required to maintain and carry the first aid kit to all team games. This person will be the first contact by a coach if ambulance or emergency personnel are required. First aid training not required.
- [Team Photographer/Media Manager](#) – take pictures at all events, share with team and have posted to website. Works with the Manager to develop and submit articles and pictures to local media sources.
- [Special Events Director](#) – This person will oversee any nongame events where volunteer coordination is required. Specifically, the Canada Day Classic Tournament, Team volunteer event.
- [Score Keeper & Stats Person](#) – will be the individual(s) who keeps score at all games, using game changer and assigning any other necessary score keeping or pitch tracking duties. Works with coaches to track specific on field activities (errors committed, who's getting on base, etc.).

# Budget & Uniforms

- **The Select team assessment will be approximately \$485.00 per player.**
- **The All-Star team assessment will be approximately \$945.00 per player. This includes a \$400.00 per player assessment for hosting provincials. This helps to cover OLL's increased expenses for hosting and is a net win for families when factoring in the cost of travel and hotel rooms.**
- **If the All-Star team qualifies for Nationals and/or the World Series travel and accommodations are covered for the players, but not for families.**
- The team budget amount is separate from uniform costs. Uniform Day for all Whitecaps teams will be May 22, 2023.
