- **Division Ages:** Divisions are based on the age of your players on September 1, 2024.
- **Number of Teams: 8 minimum, up to 12 Teams** in each division (10U, 12U)
- Each team is guaranteed **three games**. All teams will play on Friday, August 9.
- **Round Robin Divisions** will be put together based on the competitive level of your team.
- If Your Team is involved in your District, Provincial, or Canadian championship, and there is a conflict with our tournament, you will be given a full refund.

Little League Rules (for 12U and under)

- a) **Bat Rules:** Little League International Bat Rules apply (USA Bat Rules – USA Logo on bat).
- b) **Catcher Helmets:** Hockey “Goalie-style” masks are the only type that can be used. (no helmet and mask combinations). The mask must have a dangler (throat protector) on it.
Note: OLL will supply bats and catcher helmets to any team that does not have them.
- c) **Leadoffs in Little League:** A runner cannot leave the base until a pitched ball has gone past the hitter (gone over the plate). There are penalties based on the circumstance, but the runner is not automatically out.
- d) **On Deck Batter:** There is no “On-deck” batter in Little League. The only two players who can have a bat in their hands are the batter and the next player up (who is in the dugout). No hitting nets or other equipment can be set up for use during the game.
